

Autism Society Greater New Orleans 2022 Impact Report



In 2022, our organization continued to expand the services and supports we provide to the Autism community in the Greater New Orleans area. We provided access to information and resources, fostered community connections, hosted events, and continued our annual distribution of direct financial support to area families. We are proud to continue to strive to fulfill our mission to create connections, empowering everyone in the Autism community with the resources needed to live fully.



Distributed over **\$11,000 to area families and Autistic adults.**

Provided 300 backpacks filled with school supplies to area families with low barriers for participation.

Over 9,000 people accessed resources and education materials on our website.

2500+ people engaged with ASGNO's posts and content on social media.

Gave out accessible education materials on the Covid-19 Vaccine to **over 2,000 people at 6 events.**



268 attendances to our online social and support groups.

11 social and community events were held in the GNO area with over 750 attendees.



Hosted 3 inclusive vaccine clinics and administered 32 free COVID-19 vaccines to individuals of all ages and ability levels in a safe, nurturing, and positive environment.



Information & Referral Services

- **462 people assisted through our helpline** via calls, emails, and social media messages.
- Our helpline saw a **180% increase in calls and emails** compared to 2021.
- **53% of our inquiries came from caregivers** while Autistic adults represented our second-highest inquirers at 36%.
