In 2024, our organization continued to expand the services and supports we provide to the Autism community in the Greater New Orleans area. We served more people through every one of our programs in 2024 than in 2023. Additional funding is critically needed to help us scale our programs and services to match the needs of our community. We are proud to continue to strive to fulfill our mission to create connections, empowering everyone in the Autism community with the resources needed to live fully.



Trained over 100 educators and school support staff on Autism and sensory support in the classroom.



Distributed over **\$13,000 to area families and Autistic adults.** through our Mini-Grant Program

Over 15,000 people accessed resources and education materials on our website



304 attendances to our online social and support groups.

Over 100,000 people engaged with ASGNO's posts and content on social media



35 events were held in the GNO area with over 1500 attendees



Trained 120 school-based healthcare providers on Autism and our Accessible Vaccination Model.

Provided targeted education and support to 81 people through our Caregiver Training and Information series. Recordings of this series assisted an additional 100 people.



Information & Referral Services

- **Over 600 people assisted through our helpline** via calls, emails, and social media.
- The most common topics of concern were information on adult diagnostic services, and problems with both public and private schools
- **90% of individuals contacting the program were assisted within 2 days.**
