Our Impact.

Throughout the previous year, our organization continued to expand the services and support we provide in the Greater New Orleans area. We provided access to information and resources, fostered community connections, hosted events, and continued our annual distribution of direct financial support to area families.

With your generous sponsorship, we can continue to empower the Autism community and provide the resources and information needed to live fully.

Distributed over \$13,000 directly to local families and individuals through our Mini-Grant program.

Partnered with Morrison Law Group to provide 18 families with free general power of attorney for themselves or a loved one.



Hosted 4 inclusive and sensory-friendly events with a total of over 1,100 participants in attendance.

Participated in numerous events throughout the community to share resources.

Hosted online support groups each month for caregivers, Spanishspeaking caregivers and Autistic adults.
